Pastoralists Indigenous Non-Governmental Organisations Forum (PINGO's Forum) is formed in 1994 and formally registered in 1996 as a membership organisation of more than 50 CSOs members working country-wide.

PINGO's Forum is thus a national human rights organisation that advocates and promotes the rights of indigenous peoples; pastoralists and hunter-gatherers communities and amplifies their voices.

The department makes sure the organisation conducts it researches, documents them as well as publish them in various forms; ready to be consumed by different audience.




# FINANCE & ADMINISTRATION




#### **SPEED AND CONSISTENCY:**

### **ACCOMPLISHMENTS**

Since its establishment, PINGO's Forum has had ripped from its advocacy benefits, and below are some of what we are proud of...



- Engagement in formulation of the land laws a resulting into friendly provisions that support customary land ownership
- Constitution review engagement in the proposed constitution of 2014 with recognition of pastoralists and hunter gatherers as livelihood entitled to constitutional protection
- Submissions to UN Mechanisms including CESCR, Universal periodic review, special mechanisms, ACHPR, UNFCCC and the Adoption of Paris Agreement, and GCF's IPs policy
- Shaping the World Bank safeguards OP4.10 on indigenous interests
- African Commission on Human and Peoples Rights focal point for indigenous peoples
- Positive engagement in National Poverty Reduction Strategy with positive outcome to indigenous peoples.
- Support landmark and public litigation cases which ended in favour of indigenous peoples.


### ...ACCOMPLISHMENTS

### **OUR SOCIAL MEDIA**


We currently maintain a number of social media channels for communicating with the audience. These include but are not limited to the three main accounts listed below; for video, pictorials, and audio.

We realise that narrative reports might not be enough to exhaust everything from the field. That is why we have a plan for that, video reports.


On this channel, various video reports from our projects are published for the public to consume.
